

### **The Epistle**

Who is wise and understanding among you? By his good conduct let him show his works in the meekness of wisdom. But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not boast and be false to the truth. This is not the wisdom that comes down from above, but is earthly, unspiritual, demonic. For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there will be disorder and every vile practice. But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, open to reason, full of mercy and good fruits, impartial and sincere. And a harvest of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.

What causes quarrels and what causes fights among you? Is it not this, that your passions are at war within you? You desire and do not have, so you murder. You covet and cannot obtain, so you fight and quarrel. You do not have, because you do not ask. You ask and do not receive, because you ask wrongly, to spend it on your passions. You adulterous people! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God. Or do you suppose it is to no purpose that the Scripture says, "He yearns jealously over the spirit that he has made to dwell in us"? But he gives more grace. Therefore it says, "God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble." Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. Be wretched and mourn and weep. Let your laughter be turned to mourning and your joy to gloom. Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you.

**Reverend John Schmidt**

Rev. John Schmidt graduated from the St. Louis Seminary in 1992. He served St. John's Lutheran Church in Secor, Illinois from 1992-1999. He then served as an associate Pastor at Redeemer Lutheran Church in Lincoln, Nebraska from 1999-2008. He was the ninth Pastor in their history. Since November 2008 he has served as the ninth pastor in the history of St. Paul Lutheran Church. From 2009-2021 he served as circuit visitor of Circuit 23 of the Texas District. He currently serves as Chaplain of the South Lee County Volunteer Fire Department, Chairman of the Board of Directors of Cen-Tex Family Services, Inc., which provide Head Start services for Bastrop, Lee, Fayette and Colorado County.

Rev. Schmidt was born in Clinton, Missouri and grew up in Kansas City, St. Louis and Springfield Missouri. In 1985 he met Lisa Ann Hembry at Concordia Teachers College in Seward Nebraska. They were united in marriage in 1989. Lisa taught fifth and sixth grade at St. Paul for 3½ years, and from 2012-2020 she served as Director of the Early Childhood Center at St. Paul. In October 2020, she accepted a teaching position at McDade ISD, where she continues to teach the children. This union has been blessed with three children, Erich, Ann and Krista. Erich teaches Theology and Computers at Sheboygan Lutheran High School, Sheboygan, Wisconsin. Ann and Tyler Stenquist, with step daughter Miranda, and daughter Adira live in Nixa, Missouri. Ann works as a software engineer. Krista and Pablo Rodriguez live in Giddings, Texas while Krista continues teaching 4<sup>th</sup> grade at Redeemer Lutheran School in Austin, TX. Pablo and Krista have been blessed with two daughters, Elizabeth Grace and Isabella Lynn. They are expecting daughter number three in December

## **Reverend Bernard Schey**

Pastor Bernie Schey was born in Elgin, Illinois and raised in the Fox River Valley, first in Fox River Grove, and then in Carpentersville. His study of the German language began at age 14 at Dundee Community High School where he studied the language in all four years of high school (1971-75) under the guidance of Frau Penny Siewert and Herr John Burton. His lifelong interest in and study of "Deutsch" continued at Bethany Lutheran College in Mankato, MN and at Texas Lutheran College in Seguin, TX. He even spent the month of January 1979 at Fort Bliss, TX where he was an observer at the German elementary school provided for the children of the German Luftwaffe personnel. These airmen studied at the NATO "Raketenschule" there in El Paso.

After receiving his bachelor's degree in English Literature from TLC in May of 1980, Pastor Schey began study at Concordia Theological Seminary in Fort Wayne, IN. While there, he met several German exchange students from our sister seminary in Oberursel/Taunus, near Frankfurt, Germany, and from 1982-83, he participated in the same exchange program. During that year, he did extensive backpacking and rail travel to several European countries, as well as to many German cities and towns. This included a visit to Leipzig, then a part of the communist DDR—East Germany.

After ordination in 1985, Pastor Schey has served parishes in Lake Charles and New Orleans, LA, Schulenburg, TX, and Trinity in Copperas Cove, TX. In 1994, he spent one month in the Central Asian Republic of Kazakhstan as guest missionary among the German-speaking Russians there.


After an eighteen-month sabbatical, during which Pastor Schey served a total of four months at an English-speaking congregation, Trinity, in Frankfurt, Germany, he began to serve Trinity Lutheran Church in Dime Box, TX in October of 2018, where he remains. Every Advent, Pastor Schey leads a German service at St. Paul in Aleman, TX, rural Hamilton County.

## **Reverend Thomas Obersat**

Pastor Obersat is a graduate of Concordia Teachers College in Seward, NE where he received both a Bachelors in Education degree and a Master of Education. He, too, is a graduate of Concordia Theological Seminary, Ft. Wayne, 1991, attending the Lutheran seminary in Oberursel, Germany for one year as an exchange student. Pastor Obersat served congregations for about 14 years in Northwest Indiana and Berlin, Germany. During his tenure in Indiana, Pastor Obersat began his ten years of duty as a reserve military Chaplain. He has had the pleasure of serving not only in the United States but also in Australia and Germany. Pastor Obersat spent twelve years serving Lutheran classical congregational schools in Nebraska and Texas. Since August of 2017 he serves as pastor of Ebenezer Lutheran Church in Manheim, TX.

Pastor Obersat is married to his lovely wife Jane of 21 years, who is a trained deaconess with a Masters in Historical Theology from Concordia Theological Seminary, Ft. Wayne. Jane teaches at Faith Lutheran High School of Central Texas. The Lord has blessed Pastor and Jane with two children, Magdalena and Thomas Jr.

**JEREMIA 11:18-20**

Der HERR hat mir's offenbart, daß ich's weiß, und zeigte mir ihr Vornehmen, nämlich, daß sie mich wie ein armes Schaf zur Schlachtbank führen wollen. Denn ich wußte nicht, daß sie wider mich beratschlagt hatten und gesagt: Laßt uns den Baum mit seinen Früchten verderben und ihn aus dem Lande der Lebendigen ausrotten, daß seines Namens nimmermehr gedacht werde.

Aber du, HERR Zebaoth, du gerechter Richter, der du Nieren und Herzen prüfst, laß mich deine Rache über sie sehen; denn ich habe dir meine Sache befohlen.

Wer ist weise und klug unter euch? Der erzeige mit seinem guten Wandel seine Werke in der Sanftmut und Weisheit. Habt ihr aber bitteren Neid und Zank in eurem Herzen, so röhmt euch nicht und lügt nicht wider die Wahrheit. Das ist nicht die Weisheit, die von obenherab kommt, sondern irdisch, menschlich und teuflisch. Denn wo Neid und Zank ist, da ist Unordnung und eitel böses Ding. Die Weisheit von obenher ist auf's erste keusch, darnach friedsam, gelinde, läßt sich sagen, voll Barmherzigkeit und guter Früchte, unparteiisch, ohne Heuchelei. Die Frucht aber der Gerechtigkeit wird gesät im Frieden denen, die den Frieden halten. Woher kommt Streit und Krieg unter euch? Kommt's nicht daher: aus euren Wollüstern, die da streiten in euren Gliedern? Ihr seid begierig, und erlanget's damit nicht; ihr hasset und neidet, und gewinnt damit nichts; ihr streitet und krieget. Ihr habt nicht, darum daß ihr nicht bittet; ihr bittet, und nehmet nicht, darum daß ihr übel bittet, nämlich dahin, daß ihr's mit euren Wollüstern verzehrt. Ihr Ehebrecher und Ehebrecherinnen, wisset ihr nicht, daß der Welt Freundschaft Gottes Feindschaft ist? Wer der Welt Freund sein will, der wird Gottes Feind sein. Oder lasset ihr euch dünken, die Schrift sage umsonst: Der Geist, der in euch wohnt, begehrte und eiferte? Er gibt aber desto reichlicher Gnade. Darum sagt sie: "Gott widersteht den Hoffärtigen, aber den Demütigen gibt er Gnade." So seid nun Gott untätig. Widerstehet dem Teufel, so flieht er von euch; nahet euch zu Gott, so naht er sich zu euch. Reiniget die Hände, ihr Sünder, und macht eure Herzen keusch, ihr Wankelmütigen. Seid elend und traget Leid und weinet; euer Lachen verkehre sich in Weinen und eure Freude in Traurigkeit. Demütigt euch vor Gott, so wir er euch erhöhen.
